Ziptrak Manual Outdoor Blind

A track-guided blind you move by hand. The fabric runs in a channel down each side, so it is held on all four edges - no zip, no cord, no crank handle, and nothing to wire. It is the no-power way to turn a deck or patio into a room you can use when the weather turns.

HOW IT HANDLES WIND

Ziptrak test the blind system rather than claim for it. In their most recent round a 2.5 x 2.5 m blind, built with current componentry and their recommended fixings for windy areas, held a static load of 876 kg - the force of a wind over 170 km/h - and still operated afterwards. A separate pull test on the side spline reached the equivalent of 1,200 kg on one side of a 2.5 m high blind.

Two things worth knowing. A bigger blind carries more load for the same wind, so the figures above belong to that test size rather than to every blind. And open mesh lets air through, so it resists wind better than PVC, which behaves like a solid surface. Lab testing cannot reproduce real gusting either - raise your blinds in a storm.

WHY PEOPLE CHOOSE IT

- **Held on all four edges** - the side channels capture the fabric, so wind, rain, and insects stay outside
- **Spring-balanced** - push it up or pull it down and it stays where you leave it, with a centre lock at the bottom
- **Nothing to power** - no motor, no wiring, nothing to go flat, which also makes it the pick for off-grid sites
- **Safe around children and pets** - no cords, no zips, no crank handle, no external wiring
- **Mesh or clear PVC** - shade, privacy, and airflow, or a clear weather enclosure

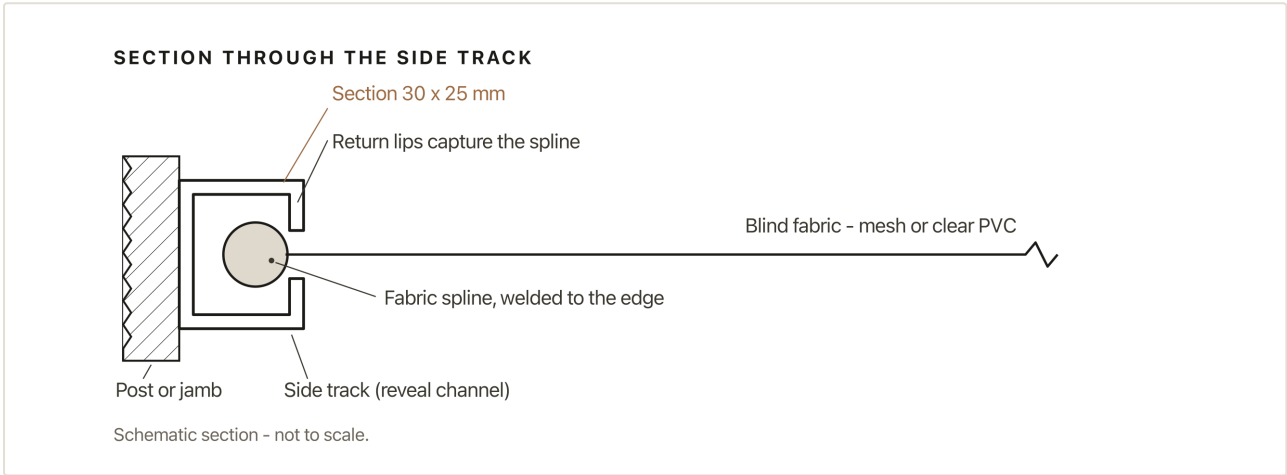

Specifications

Span	Made to measure, to about 4 m wide - wider or heavier openings move to the motorised Executive
Operation	Spring-balanced by hand, locking at any height. Motorisation available for high or hard-to-reach openings
Retention	Captured zip-track side channels, holding the fabric on all four edges
Finish	Powder-coated, colour-matched to the Dulux range - Matt as standard

THE FABRIC RANGE

- **Standard insect mesh** - 18x14 weave, ~58% open - what almost every home chooses.
- **Clear PVC** - glass-like full enclosure for weather and heat retention.
- **Midge & no-see-um mesh** - finer 18x18 weave (~48% open) for coasts, estuaries, and bush.
- **Outdoor privacy fabrics** - Vtex Extreme / Plus / Ultra / View colourways.
- **Solar / privacy mesh** - E-Screen, 10% or 6% openness - cuts heat, glare, and UV.
